

LIABILITY RELEASE AND MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION FORM FOR MINOR PARTICIPATION AND TRAVEL

_____ Initials My minor child, _____, has my permission and consent to travel to and from American Youth Services, Inc. (“AYS”) BILT Camp and to participate in all camp activities during BILT Camp 2021 (the “Event”).

_____ Initials I am the undersigned parent/guardian and I acknowledge and understand that my child’s participation and travel to and from the Event may involve risk of serious injury or death, including losses which may result not only from my child’s own actions, inactions or negligence, but also from the actions, inactions or negligence of others. AYS made the arrangements and provided funding for the food, lodging, and travel to and from the Event. AYS is not providing supervision for the Event. I understand that if I have any risk concerns regarding travel or participation in the Event, I should discuss the risks associated with my child’s participation in the Event with the Event supervisors, staff and volunteers before I sign this document and before travel begins.

_____ Initials I acknowledge that pictures or videos may be taken of my minor child during the event. I consent that AYS may copyright assign, and use such images for lawful purposes including promotion, advertising, and web.

Liability Release and Indemnification

_____ Initials In consideration of allowing my child to participate in and travel to and from the Event, I hereby release and hold harmless AYS, its board of directors, officers, employees, members, volunteers and other participants and agents (collectively, the “Released Parties”) from and against any and all claims, demands, losses, and liabilities that my child may assert or sustain arising from his or her travel to, and participation in, the Event.

_____ Initials COVID-19 is an extremely contagious virus that spreads easily through person-to-person contact. Federal and state authorities recommend social distancing to prevent the spread of the virus. COVID-19 can lead to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and death. Participating in the Event programs or accessing the Event facilities could increase the risk of contracting COVID-19 and AYS in no way warrants that COVID-19 infection will not occur through such actions.

Army & Navy Academy Liability Agreement

To be distributed to all Guest Campers, Staff, Chaperones, and Parents / Guardians of participating minors. Please return to Summer Programs office immediately upon Camp Leader's arrival on campus.

While The Army and Navy Academy ("The Academy") has adopted many rules and practices to foster an atmosphere of learning and safety, The Academy recognizes that voluntary participation in activities available to any camper ("Participant") may result in injuries. Participants are expected to obey the rules of The Academy established to promote health and safety, at all times during their visit.

For prudent business reasons, The Academy requires all Participants (or their parents/guardians if the participant is a minor), staff and chaperones to be given a copy of this Liability Agreement and accept its contents as a condition of their usage of Academy facilities.

1. Participant hereby acknowledges that they are a voluntary camp participant and may voluntarily participate in activities on the Academy campus, or other Southern California locations. The term "activities" includes baseball, basketball, wrestling, martial arts, swimming, surfing, body boarding, racquet sports, field sports (e.g., soccer, football), fitness exercise, gymnastics, arts & crafts, and similar activities.
2. Participant is aware that The Academy has adopted certain rules to promote participant safety. They have read the rules, and agree to abide by them at all times during their stay at The Academy.
3. Participant is aware that certain activities have inherent dangers that no amount of care, caution, instruction or expertise can eliminate. Given the opportunity to participate in activities, any participation will be voluntary, with full acceptance of the risks involved. Participant hereby agrees to accept any and all risks of injury, death, or damage to property associated with their participation in activities during their stay at The Academy. Participation in camp activities will be considered acceptance of this statement.
4. As consideration for The Academy allowing Participant access to its grounds and facilities, the Participant agrees that their assignees, heirs, guardians and legal representatives will not make a claim against, sue or attach the property of The Academy, its affiliated organizations or employees, for injury, wrongful death or damage to property related to their participation in camp activities and resulting from either negligence or other acts by any employee, agent or contractor of The Academy.
5. Participant hereby releases The Academy its employees and affiliated organizations from all actions, claims or demands that they themselves, their assignees, heirs, guardians or legal representatives now have, or may hereafter have and hold each of them harmless from any and all claims or causes of actions for personal injuries, wrongful death or property damage, arising from their participation in camp activities during their stay at The Academy.
6. The Participant or their assigns, on behalf of themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators agrees that in the event that any claim for personal injury, wrongful death or property damage is prosecuted against The Academy, the liability of the Academy its employees or affiliated organizations is expressly limited to the amount of the charges paid to it.

The Participant (or parent/guardian of participating minor) has carefully read this agreement and is fully aware of the potential dangers incidental to participating camp activities. They are aware that this agreement, once executed, is a release of liability and a contract between themselves and The Academy, its employees and affiliated organizations, and accepts it of their own free will.
